THIS MATTER having come on for hearing before the undersigned Judge of the above-entitled court upon the defendant's oral notice of his/her intent to petition the court for acceptance into a deferred prosecution, and the court having considered the records and files herein and being fully advised in the premises:

ORDERED, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

1. The defendant shall attend a minimum of two (2) 12-step self help group meetings (AA, NA, etc.) per week and provide written proof of such attendance to the court at each court hearing;
2. The defendant shall comply with all court orders including Orders of Release;
3. The defendant shall abstain from consumption of alcohol and any drug not prescribed by a physician;
4. The defendant shall not drive without a valid license, proof of insurance and ignition interlock for personal use for employment/commercial use.

ORDERED, THAT BEFORE THE NEXT COURT HEARING, THE DEFENDANT SHALL FILE PROOF OF THE FOLLOWING:

1. The defendant shall pay \$250 administrative costs;
2. The defendant shall attend a DUI Victim's Panel;
3. The defendant shall submit all documentation in support of the petition for deferred prosecution to Court Probation Monitoring Clerk and City Prosecuting Attorney at least seven days prior to the next court date;
4. The defendant shall complete through a state-certified agency a chemical dependency evaluation mental health evaluation.

YOUR FAILURE TO COMPLETELY SATISFY THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS MAY RESULT IN A DENIAL OF YOUR PETITION FOR DEFERRED PROSECUTION

The defendant has a .08 breath test (or higher). The defendant may request a stay of the administrative license suspension directly through the Washington State Department of Licensing (DOL) [RCW 46.20.308(10)(a), SSB 5644.SL July 2005.] **WARNING:** There is no stay until, and if, ordered by DOL.
