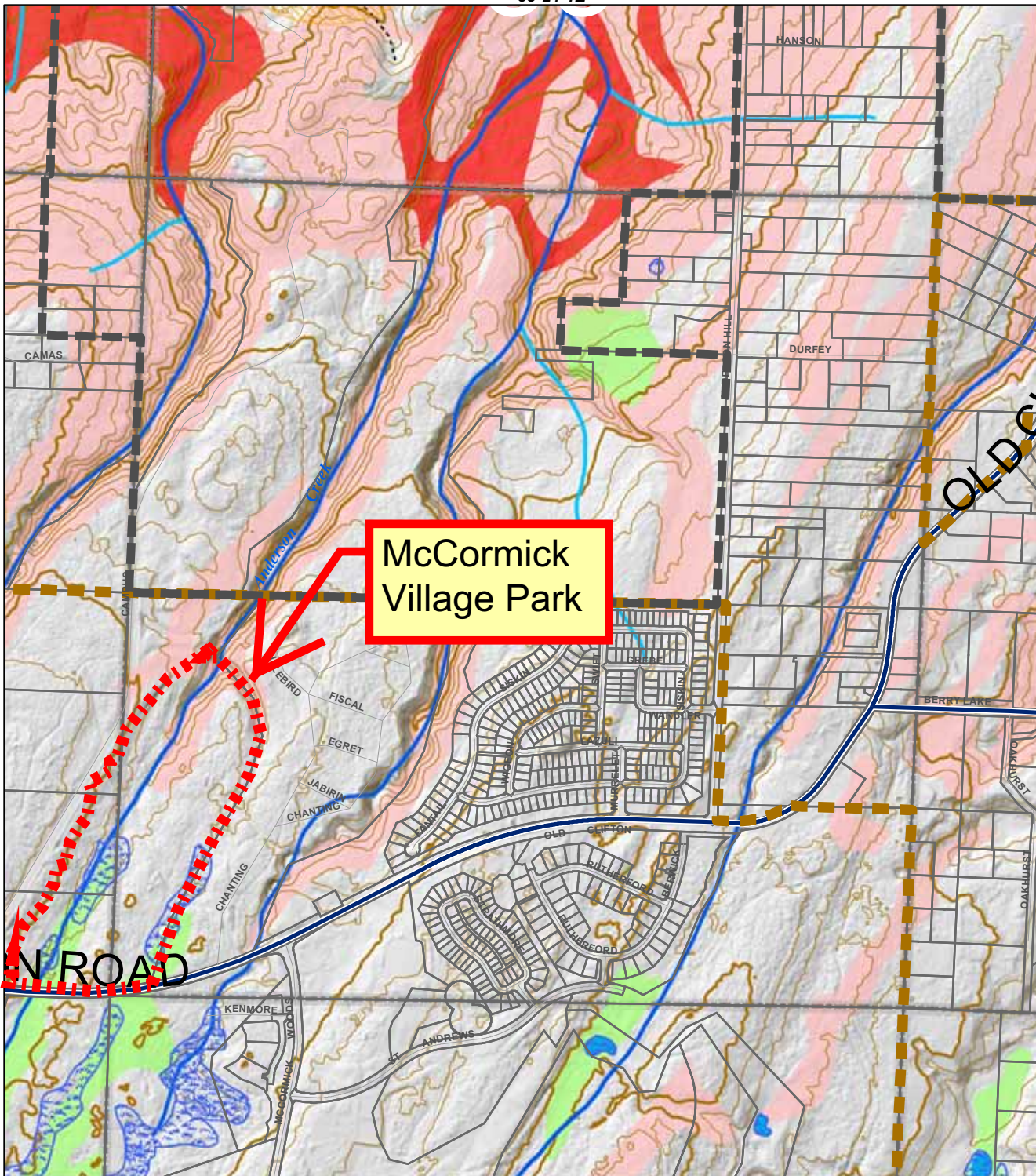

- ### Bald Eagle Habitat Buffer
- Priority 1: 400' buffer around nest trees/roost sites. Requires a management plan tailored for the specific land use.
 - Priority 2: w/in 400'-800' of nest trees, has specific vegetation retention requirements; also w/in 800' and 1/2 mile and w/in 250' of shoreline, also has specific requirements.

FEMA Flood Zones A /AE
- Hydric Soils

- ### Geologically Hazardous Areas
- High Hazard Areas : Slopes >30% and mapped as "Unstable", "Unstable Old Slides" or "Unstable Recent Slides"
 - Moderate Hazard Areas; Slopes 15%-30%, including intermediate stability slopes, soils classed as "highly/potentially highly erodible", soils with springs or groundwater seepage, and soils subject to liquefaction from earthquakes.

- (S) Designated Shorelines of the State
 - (F) Fish Habitat.
 - (N) Non-fish Habitat.
 - (U) Unknown, unmodeled hydrographic feature.
 - Bay, Estuary, Puget Sound
